Plaintiffs have moved, without opposition from Defendants, to permit Garden City Group ("GCG"), the Claims Administrator, to make payments directly to Trust Administration Class members deemed "whereabouts unknown" by the Department of Interior where GCG has received contact information for that class member:

Upon consideration of that motion, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. GCG is hereby authorized to distribute settlement payments to members of the Trust Administration Class who are considered whereabouts unknown by Interior where GCG has been provided contact information by the class member and it has not subsequently sent a mailing to that address which was returned as undeliverable.

2. In the event that any such mailing is returned as undeliverable and that class member has an open Individual Indian Money ("IIM") account, said funds shall be deposited in that class member's IIM account.
